M25 junction 28 improvement scheme: Preferred route announcement

Between 14 November 2016 and 6 January 2017 Highways England consulted on proposed improvements to junction 28 as part of the M25 improvement scheme in your constituency.

We have now analysed all responses from the public consultation, which demonstrate that there is strong support for Option 5F (49%) as it is better able to reduce congestion and delays at the junction.

As this option is also predicted to deliver very good value for money and greater network resilience for future use, we are pleased to announce the preferred route is Option 5F.

Please find enclosed our preferred route announcement leaflet that provides the detail on our decision and the feedback we received from the public consultation. If you would like to read the full Public Consultation Report, then you can do so by visiting www.highways.gov.uk/m25j28.

A second consultation will take place early in 2018, where customers will have another opportunity to give their views and influence the developments of the design. We will let you know more about this nearer the time.
